

The Relationships Between The China's Housing Conditions and Occupations of Householders-A Study Based on The China Population Census

This paper shows the detailed study on the relationships between the housing conditions (mainly including the housing sources and the housing area) and occupations of householders, basing on the Fifth and Sixth China Population Census. The study indicates that from the perspective of housing area, the section leaders which are in the government offices, Institutional Organization, professional elite and the clerk have larger housing area than other occupations, and from the housing source perspective, in terms of market-oriented housing ratio or self-owned housing ratio, the section leaders which are in the government offices, Institutional Organization, professional elite and the clerk are also in the leading position. Besides, such occupations that mentioned above have largely occupied economically affordable housing which belonging to the housing difficult groups originally.
